


Updates on the CVHS Capital Campaign

In March, Cocheco Valley Humane Society signed a 98-year-lease with Strafford County allowing us to move forward with our plans to build a new shelter on county land in the Strafford County Complex. Since the lease signing, we've had many exciting updates to our Bring Us Home Capital Campaign, including:

- Michael J. O'Connell (pictured right), MD, MHA, and CEO of Paincare, Salmon Falls Family Healthcare, and R.O.A.D. to a Better Life, generously donated \$250,000 to support our "Bring Us Home" capital campaign to build a new animal shelter. His tremendous gift brings us one step closer to our new home and we will proudly recognize his contribution with the naming of the surgical suite.
- Our friends at **Kennebunk Savings Bank granted a \$50,000 matching gift** to the campaign and will match all donations up to that amount that are given through the end of October.
- Petco Foundation has awarded CVHS \$50,000 for the capital campaign.
- We are working on a new program called **Kids 4 Cocheco** designed to help get children involved in our journey towards a new home. Stay tuned for more information! 
